To Whom it May Concern,

I am sending this notice in regards to the masking, testing, and vaccine requirements set forth by the California CDC for staff and students at both public and private schools. Facial coverings are found to be ineffective for the purpose claimed by the mandate and requesting a person to wear such device as part of an emergency use authorization without their consent is illegal.

According to the National Institutes of Health, the size of the SARS-CoV-2 particle is about 0.1 microns.¹ In comparison, the size of a wildfire smoke particle is 2.5 microns²—much bigger than a COVID particle. Taking that into consideration, the CDC states that “cloth masks will not protect you from wildfire smoke,”³ it’s safe to assume that cloth masks cannot provide adequate protection from the transmission of SARS-CoV-2.

In addition to this information, The CDC has also published a study stating there is “no significant reduction in influenza transmission with the use of face masks.”⁴ The size of an airborne flu particulate is the same as the SARS-CoV-2 particulate, less than 0.1 microns. Therefore, the typical standard cloth and surgical masks offer next to no protection against virus-sized particles or small aerosols.

Regardless of the lack of safety and efficacy of personal respiratory protective devices, according to Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) law, it is illegal to mandate investigational medical therapies without informed consent. All SARS-Co-V-2 PCR and antigen tests⁵, vaccines⁶, and masks⁷ are only EUA-authorized, not approved or licensed by the federal government, i.e., long -term safety and efficacy have not been proven. EU authorizations are by definition experimental, which according to the CDC, requires people be given the right to refuse them.⁸ Therefore, mandating anything authorized as emergency use, without consent, is illegal and generates liability for the mandating party.
